New family registration fee is \$125.00 per family. This fee is non-refundable pending acceptance to St. John the Baptist Catholic School. Each family (k-8) is assessed a non-refundable \$450.00 Activity Fee. Each family (ps-8) is assessed a non-refundable \$125.00 COVID Cleaning Fee.

Current family registration fee is \$125.00 per family through 2/28. Late registration fee is \$175.00 after 3/1. This fee is non-refundable pending acceptance to St. John the Baptist Catholic School. Each family is assessed a non-refundable \$450.00 Activity Fee and a non-refundable \$125.00 COVID Cleaning Fee.

The \$450.00 Activity Fee includes the costs associated with technology as well as student enrichment & events. One yearbook per family will be included in the Activity Fee. Families in K-8 or preschool desiring additional yearbooks may place order on the Schedule of Fees.

There are three available options for payment of tuition with due dates of the 1st, 20th, or 25th. Parents select payment option and payment date at registration.

- One payment, due July 2022. A 3% discount applies to this option.
- Two payments, due by July 2022 and by January 2023.
- Ten payments, beginning July 2022 and continuing through April 2023.

All tuition payments will be managed through Blackbaud (formerly named SMART) Tuition. The annual \$40.00 fee per family for this service is included in the tuition rates. A \$40.00 fee will be assessed to late payments.

Financial assistance is available. Applications for tuition assistance should be completed at <u>www.factstuitionaid.com</u>. All applications must be completed by March 1, 2022 to be considered for assistance.

Registration materials for the 2022-2023 school year will not be processed until the family's tuition payments are current or a formal alternative financing agreement has been established with the Parish Finance Office.

ADMISSIONS AND REGISTRATION

POLICY 5110 NON-DISCRIMINATION

Schools operated under the auspices of the Diocese of Joliet admit students of any race, color, sex, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally available to students at the schools. Questions and/or concerns regarding discrimination in admissions should be directed to the principal (if applicable) the pastor (or parish administrator) and the Superintendent of Schools in the Diocese of Joliet. The names of the elementary and secondary schools can be found in the OFFICIAL CATHOLIC DIRECTORY, published annually.

ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

Religious formation is a primary purpose of Catholic education. An interview with the principal to assess the religious and academic commitment of parents or guardians is customary. The SJB School Board sets forth the school admission policy. Copies of the admissions policy are available upon request.

POLICY 5130 ADMISSION AGES

A child entering first grade must be six years of age (kindergarten, five years; pre-school three or four years of age respectively) on or before September 1 of that year. The verification of age with a birth certificate is presented at application time. The school maintains certified copies birth certificates for each student enrolled upon enrollment.

Registration for the next school year begins in mid-January. Registration materials are sent out to currently enrolled families and families seeking enrollment for the first time. A non-refundable pre-registration fee of \$100 is required. Notification of placement on a wait list is conveyed by February 15th.

Families are encouraged to register and become active, contributing members of St. John the Baptist Parish. SJB believes that active participation in parish life is an important element in the development of the student.

St. John the Baptist Catholic School is partially funded through tuition. Tuition rates are available for the current school year through the school office. The parish subsidizes all students' education and further financial assistance is available for qualifying families. Since fundraising contributes to the revenues of the school, each family is expected to participate to the extent they are able.

Priority of Admission is based upon the following:

- a. Families with students currently in St. John's Preschool through grade eight
- b. Families who wish to transfer students from the Parish Religious Education program
- c. Parishioners whose child is entering preschool and continues onto kindergarten and first grade.
- d. Parishioners registering students for the first time
- e. Families new to St. John the Baptist, who are registered parishioners, and belong to supporting parish (St. Mary Catholic Church/St. Irene Catholic Church)
- f. Families new to St. John the Baptist, who are practicing Catholics in another parish
- g. Non-parishioners who are transferring from another school or who are first time registrants.

The waiting list will not be maintained from year to school year except for siblings of currently enrolled students. Parents or guardians of all students on the waiting list must reapply to be considered for the following school year.
